- 2. Be mindful of clicking links in texts and emails that may look like package tracking URLs. While it may look like the tracking information for your package, it could very well be a "phishing" attempt to steal your data or install a virus.
- 3. Review your credit and debit card transactions and report any unauthorized activity immediately to the financial institution involved.
- 4. Be selective of the apps you download and check for software updates regularly from Microsoft Windows and Apple IOS, as they typically include security patches or enhancements that improve the security of your data.
- 5. If you use a public Wi-Fi network, consider installing a Virtual Private Network (VPN) on your device, encrypting your data and hiding your IP address.
